



Star Car: 1948 Tucker 48

The 1948 Tucker 48 (Estimate: \$1.75m-\$2.25m) presented here was one of the few actually completed at the Tucker factory and not assembled after the fact. Of the 51 produced, only 12 were finished in the attractive Waltz Blue Metallic. This Tucker 48 has very low mileage and comes with a well-documented provenance that includes the esteemed Cofer Collection. It is very much among the finest surviving Tuckers built and still retains its original interior upholstery and engine.

The 1960 Alfa Romeo Giulietta SZ Series I Round Tail (Est.: \$500k-\$600k) was a factory-built racing car with a higher-performance Veloce engine (Tipo 00120), a 5-speed gearbox, three-leading shoe front brakes, larger fuel tank, and lightweight, all-aluminum bodywork by Zagato of Milan. These cars dominated the Italian 1300 category and were very popular with both amateur and professional racing drivers. This car, chassis 33, is an early production example originally finished in gray and sold to racing driver Rinaldo Parmigiani. With this car, he took part in the 4 Hours of Pescara in August '61 and the famous Coppa Inter Europa at Monza in September '61. The car remained in Italy until 1978, when it was exported to the U.S. It has been off the road since 1987 and has never before been presented at public auction.

My star car selection for our 2020 Arizona sale is the 1930 Cadillac V16 Sport Phaeton (Est. \$900k-\$1.2m, offered without reserve) from the John D. Groendyke Collection. This is a four-owner car from new over its 90-year lifespan, with its second owner, a Walden J. Schmitz, having purchased it in the early 1960s. Schmitz restored the car and took it to CCCA meets through the early 1970s. It was sold from his estate in 1998. This is a genuine, exceptional car in striking colors and with entirely matching numbers.

My sleeper selection for this year's sale is particularly appropriate because you can do just that sleep in it. The Spartan Spartanette Camper (Est: \$75k-\$125k, offered without reserve) is a rolling, 31-foot, award-winning example of Mid-Century Modern luxury design. It is complete with a full bathroom, original appliances, water heater, and refinished original birch interior. More and more we're seeing collectors look for quirky items that complement their existing car collections, and weird and wonderful pieces like the Spartanette have proven to surprise us across our annual catalog sales, igniting bidding wars and surpassing our expectations.



Star Car: 2019 McLaren Senna

by the time production began, the 2019 McLaren Senna hypercar will undoubtedly be a star at our 49th Scottsdale Auction this January. Following in the footsteps of the illustrious McLaren F1 and P1, and named after legendary racer Ayrton Senna, the Senna boasts performance worthy of its namesake. Built to be street legal but designed for the track, the Senna is arguably the most technologically advanced and powerful road car McLaren has ever produced.

Owned by the late actor Paul Walker, this 1991 BMW M3 will be the lowest-mileage E30 ever sold at a Barrett-Jackson auction, with fewer than 6,600 miles on the clock. Built by BMW Motorsport Division to be homologated for racing, the E30 M3's hood and roof are the only aspects of the body shared with the standard 3 Series E30. The S14 inline 4 engine produced a factory rated 195 hp and 170 ft-lb of torque, making the M3 perfectly suited for a road course or rally stage. Aside from the flared fenders, the E30 M3 also came equipped with larger brakes and tires, as well as BBS wheels. This M3 is finished in Alpine White II over a black interior. It is truly one of the best examples on the market.

best original-equipment parts for many years, Ed's team restored the car to its current glory. It was Judged OE Gold Certified upon its show debut — a significant feat. It importantly still retains its original 440 Six Pack engine, is equipped with the highly desirable 4-speed manual transmission and is very well documented. It is one of only five built in 1971, making it extremely rare and a member of the "Seven Figure" muscle-car club. This car is known as the "The Whiskey 'Cuda," as Ed is transitioning into his new career as founder of Belfour Spirits, a distiller of the finest whiskies.

While not the most expensive car on the docket, the sleeper car of the auction may well be the oneyear only production **1934 Auburn 850Y custom phaeton**. The striking phaeton coachwork designed by the legendary Al Leamy, is presented in its factory-original color scheme. It is one of only 285 examples
built, and its Art Deco styling makes it one of the most attractive ACD cars of the era. It is an ACD Category
1-certified car that has been expertly restored. We expect strong interest in this wonderful Auburn due to its striking coachwork and very limited production. Such cars are highly sought after and rarely available in the market.



However, if you're after a crown jewel for your collection, Friday and Saturday nights are made for that - and packedhouse television crowds. Muscle cars have reigned supreme forever at Barrett-Jackson, now boosted by the resto-mod movement, but they always consign







ARIZONA - AUCTION PURCHASING TIPS

Buying Smart

Ten tips for your first — or next — auction purchase



uying a classic car at auction can be a thrilling experience. I used the word "thrilling," since that can apply equally as well to a wild ride safely strapped into an old wooden roller coaster — or jumping out of a perfectly good airplane with a defective parachute. But there are ways to mitigate the potential for drama — meaning the "after-sale" hangover when you discover that the car you bought at auction didn't turn out to be the dream car you thought it was.

1. Get down and dirty

Bring a small powerful flashlight (not your phone) and look underneath the car. Look for weld patches, slathered-on undercoating, rust holes, rusty fuel and brakes lines and the like. It doesn't need to be pristine, but make sure the appearance of the chassis lines up with the story being told about the car.

2. Big picture, little picture

Inspect every car you plan to bid on. Start by getting a general feel for the car. The overall appearance. Now, break the car down into smaller bites. Spend a bunch of time on the paint, body and chassis. Check the body gaps. Check all over for incorrect use of body putty — such as filling in gaping holes in the lower quarters or rocker panels. A small magnet can help. Break the car down into the pieces and parts. Chrome, trim, interior, engine bay, etc. If you only see the big picture, you'll miss the little details.

3. Watch the auction block

If the car you want to buy has a reserve, keep a keen eye on or near the auction podium for the seller. Most of the time, auction houses will use a seller's representative (aka the "grinder") to try and get the seller to drop their reserve. This is the dynamic in play — meaning the ringman will try to bring up your bid while the grinder tries to lift the reserve. If you're able, watch this interaction closely and hold your bid to apply more pressure on the seller. You may score a bargain.

4. Never buy from the cheap seats

Unless you've looked over a car before it's on the block, never, and I mean never, start bidding on it from the back row by the bidder's bar. If a car seems too cheap, there's probably a good reason for it. If you like to gamble, bid away, my friend — the auctioneer will love you.

5. Control the bid

Try and remain calm and in control of the amount you want to bid. The auctioneer may be suggesting a \$5,000 bid, but you don't need to bid that amount. Just tell your ringman how much you want to bid, for example, \$1,000 more. On higher-price cars, it might not be possible, but you can usually "halve" the advancement if the bidding slows to only two buyers. There will be a lot of pressure to get your bid in quickly by the ringman and auctioneer. That's their job. No matter how much you prepare for this, unless you've done it before, you may be caught off guard. Your best defense is to stick to your maximum bid. Their best offense is reading how much you want the car — and they are remarkably good at it.

Bring a buddy or hire an expert

If you don't know much about old cars and all the potential traps, bring a knowledgeable buddy or pay an expert to help you. The money you spend on a professional will be money well spent. This is no place to experiment with DIY if you've never played the game before.

7. Play Columbo

Once you've zeroed in on the car you'd like to put in your garage, spend the time to look it over carefully. Most of the time the owners won't be around — but if they are, ask a lot of questions. Spend time with the car and really look it over. Visit it several times if needed. Don't be in a rush. Be there when they auction staff starts and moves the car into the sale line. Follow it into the staging lanes. Hang back and see what others might be saying about the car. This is a good time to take notes and be a detective.

8. Stick to your maximum bid

Once a car passes all the sniff tests, it's time to set your maximum budget. Do your homework. Bring along an SCM Pocket Price Guide to see the current valuation framework. Check other online sources. Crunch the numbers. Set your maximum bid, including the buyer's premium, and stick to it. Do not let the ringman persuade you to try just one more bid. They will "work you" to see if you'll buckle under the ever-so-friendly disguise as your new best friend. Be firm. Walk away. Bid another day.

9. Auction estimates

Some auction houses use estimates to suggest a selling range for a particular car. That's fine, but do your own homework. Those estimates are usually negotiations between the seller and the auction house. The best thing about them is that they do represent the range at which the car will likely sell (if the car has a reserve). If the estimate seems crazy, it very well could be — or the car may be a phenomenal example that deserves every penny. Every car must be carefully examined in person to substantiate the selling range.

10. Trust but verify

A very well-known classic-car auction house owner once told me that there was something wrong with every car sold at auction. It might be something insignificant, or something really horrible. None of them are perfect. It simply doesn't exist. Don't jump in with starry eyes and an open wallet. Be cautious. Ask questions. And do your homework. It will still be thrilling, but way better than jumping out of a perfectly good airplane with a defective parachute.


