That's why the decision was made to reschedule the 2021 Barrett-Jackson Scottsdale Auction. This year's sale begins on Saturday, March 20, and runs until Saturday, March 27. "The World's Greatest Collector Car Auction" will feature some of the most coveted collector cars on a docket rich with diversity, including modern supercars, professionally built resto-mods, customs and classics.



Worldwide's annual Scottsdale Auction will be staged as a simultaneous live and digital event at its headquarters, rather than the traditional Arizona venue. A hand-selected offering of pre-war automobiles, classics, sports, exotics and select American muscle will cross the block in Auburn, IN, with 80% of consignments offered without reserve. "The decision to move our Arizona sale to Indiana in the new year was an easy one, given the curtailment and cancellation of so many of the live events that make up a traditional Arizona Car Week, amid ongoing health and safety concerns," says Rod Egan, Worldwide Principal and Auctioneer. "We have already accommodated a very safe and successful live sale here in the fall with our Auburn Auction. The facility is ideally suited to the moment: extremely spacious and climate-controlled, with all recommended public health measures already in place and ample car storage."






