

"Riesentöter," Giant Killer

Among the "plastic" Porsches, the 910 stands out

hich Porsche was the greatest giant killer of them all? Clearly, the answer to that question will elicit a broad range of answers. Among car nerds, such a debate might well go on into the small hours (or at least until they run out of lubrication).

Among the "plastic" Porsches that will be featured at this year's The Amelia Concours, the model that consistently punched above its weight class was the relatively unknown 910. Even among Porsche enthusiasts, the 910 prototype tends to draw blank looks. Perhaps this is because of its one-season career as a Works racer, or perhaps because the 910 is not much of a looker. "Gormless" is the Britishism that seems to apply.

Another product of Ferry Porsche's nephew Ferdinand Piëch, who had been given Porsche's racing division as his fiefdom in 1965, the 910 performed its pugilistic wonders in 1967. Keeping with the company's engineering tradition, it was the evolutionary successor to the 1966 Carrera 6 (906). It incorporated

everything worth keeping from the previous model and replaced everything else with fresh, state-of-the-art components.

The Carrera 6's steel space-frame chassis, the windshield, the general shape, the transmission and the brilliant 911-derived 6-cylinder racing engine were retained. The suspension system, brakes, 13-inch centerlocking wheels and that dull body — which proved to be 25% lower in aerodynamic drag — were new.

Out of order

To further confuse the world, the 910 chronologically preceded the subsequent 907 and 908 racing models. These were the years when Porsche had stepped up to big-time international championship racing by churning out an unprecedented number of sports-racing prototypes. Indeed, between 1964 and 1969, the men at Porsche produced the 904, the 906, the 910, the 907, three varieties of the 908 and the immortal 917.

Sadly for the 910, it appeared for

the 1967 racing season, which was dominated by the Ford-Ferrari shoot-out, as well as by the appearance of the Chaparral, the winged wonder car from Midlands, TX. So from the start, the motoring press ignored the 910. Worse, the Porsche competed against 7.0-liter Fords and Chaparrals and 4.0-liter Ferrari prototypes with just a 2.0- or 2.2-liter engine.

The 910 used an 8-cylinder, Type 771, 2.2-liter, quad-cam powerplant in hillclimbs and shorter races. The heavy, long-distance grinds were initially reserved for an injected version of the racing 911 engine. Overall, the 910 was an immense step forward over the Carrera 6: lighter, grippier, slipperier and with handling that elicited praise from professional drivers and road testers alike.

The new 13-inch wheels and Lotus-Formula-One-car-derived suspension now replacing the Carrera 6's recycled 904 assemblies were responsible for the transformation. The lower front wing line afforded by the smaller wheels made visibility a real plus. Happily, the new body also


dispensed with the Carrera 6 gullwing doors, with their terrifying propensity not just to pop open, but literally blow off at speed.

The 910 originally showed its form during the 1966 European Hillclimb Championship. Starting in July, so-called 910 "Bergspyders" began to appear and quickly became the class of the field over Ferrari Dino and Abarth competition. After it proved effective on the mountains in 1966, Porsche adopted the 910 for endurance racing in 1967.

Light as a feather

Porsche engineering had always been focused on light weight. Coming in at the FIA's Appendix J minimum weight limit of 1,265 pounds, the 910 enjoyed excellent performance for a mere 2.0-liter car. However, this feather-light construction came at a price. Highly stressed 906 tube frames had been known to fail after hard endurance racing.

So it was that for the 1967 season, Piëch instituted an unprecedented racing policy: Only brand-new cars would be used in important races.

Accordingly, while all 910 prototypes were intended for exclusive factory use, by July Porsche had built 28 cars. For 1969, while Porsche was building its infamous 25-car lineup of 917s, it also took advantage of the same 25-car sports-car rule to homologate the 910 prototype as a sports car, just what the bevy of "used" 910 privateer buyers needed.

A single point

So how did the 910 perform in 1967? It was 4th overall at Daytona, 3rd and 4th at Sebring, 3rd and 5th at Monza, and 2nd and 7th at Spa. It swept the podium at the Targa Florio and finished 1st through 4th overall at the Nürburgring. It was 6th at Le Mans.

Going into the BOAC 500 race at Brands Hatch on July 30, the overall World Sportscar Championship was on the line, with either Porsche or Ferrari able to win it depending on the finish. Chaparral won the race, Ferrari came in 2nd and a Porsche 910 finished 3rd.

Porsche finished 2nd in the series championship to Ferrari by a single point. (The Brands Hatch result was subsequently repeated at Montlhéry, with another 3rd-place finish for Porsche behind a Ford and a Ferrari.) Now that's punching above your weight — and quite an impressive result for a short-lived model that nobody much remembers. •

The Amelia Island Auction

Bonhams returns to Amelia Island for the eighth time, based again at Fernandina Beach Golf Club, where it will hold the first auction of the week. Last year, Bonhams' top seller was a 1955 Porsche 550 Spyder, offered for sale for the first time in 50 years, which achieved \$4.2m. Other cars of note included a 1929 Duesenberg Model J Convertible Victoria that realized \$1.1m, a 1954 Jaguar XK 120 SE coupe with coachwork by Pinin Farina at \$940k, a 1933 Bentley 31/2 Litre Sports Tourer, reported to be the first production Derby Bentley, for \$429k, and a 1908 Ford Model T Tourer that is believed to be the model's oldest surviving example, at \$246k.
